- Tracks prospective auditor changes as disclosed in annual reports, annual general meetings, and press releases. Key data points include departing and engaged auditors, date of announcement, and the fiscal year to be audited by the engaged auditor.

- Tracks current auditor(s) of record. Key data points include current auditor and auditor tenure.
- Covers historical and current engagements

■ Financial Restatements

- Tracks corrections of errors (disclosed in English) affecting the financial statements due to clerical error, misapplication of accounting standards, or fraud (collectively "restatements").
- Covers 2017 – Present

■ Key Audit Matters

- Tracks individual KAMs disclosed in English, normalizes the topic, pulls the text of title and description, and the auditor's response.
- Covers 2014 – Present (UK and Netherlands)
Covers 2016 – Present (all other EEA & Switzerland)

■ Transparency Reports

- Tracks Transparency Reports published annually by EEA, UK, and Switzerland-located audit firms and the normalized names of all entities disclosed on each firm's report.
- Covers 2011 – Present
